The Adviser uses both a quantitative and a fundamental approach to identify stocks that are undervalued compared to a company's financial Condition.

Established in 1854, HM Payson is one of the oldest independent investment advisors in the United States. As of December 31, 2020 assets under management, including the Payson Total Return Fund, totaled approximately \$5.09 billion.

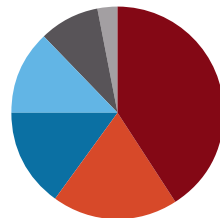

Equity Sector Weights



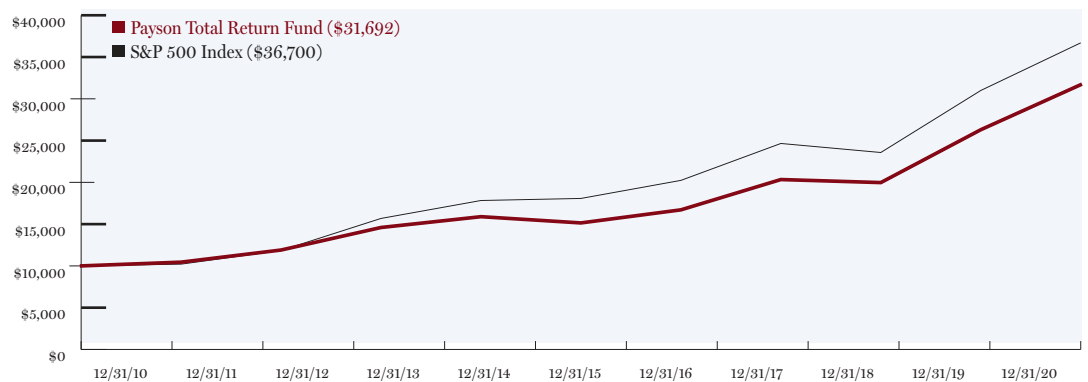
